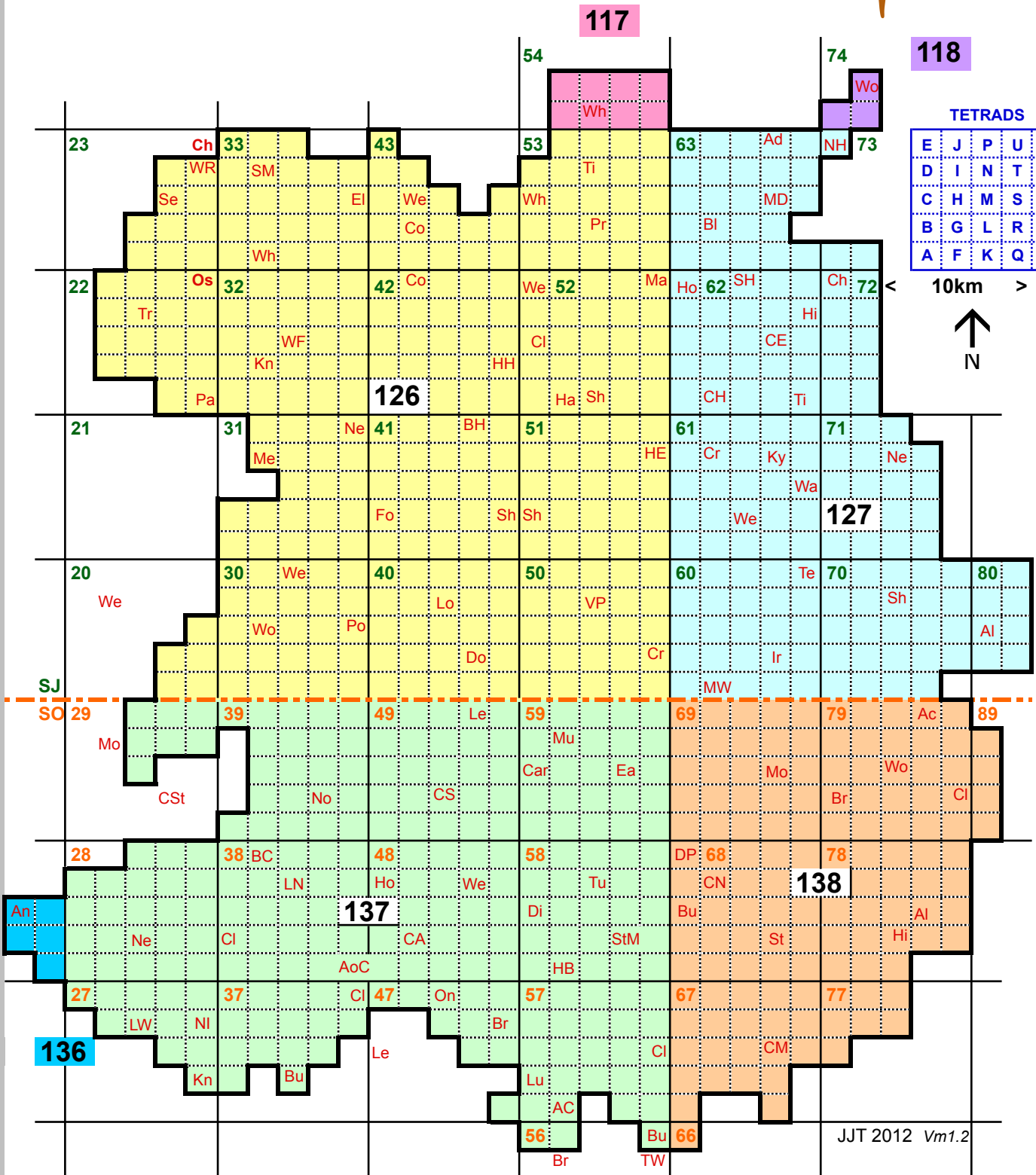


TETRADS of Shropshire (n=870)

Shropshire tetrads

If you know about and use tetrads and if have an understanding of *Excel* you may find this useful. It is here as an *Excel* and PDF files open for you to copy and use as you wish. It currently prints on A4. Please do not redistribute, but instead point interested parties to this website.

10km squares are bounded by thin lines, tetrads by dotted lines (n=870).

10km square two-figure numbers are given in the NW corner of each 10km and the orange dashed line is the division between SO and SJ.

SO square numbers are **Orange** and SJ square numbers are **green** (from **Jade**), a coding I used for the site filing system at SWT.

I have added some two letter abbreviations of some place names within tetrads in broadly their correct positions within square, as a guide.
